## Details, Details, Details

Building a good house requires an enormous attention to detail.  
We thought you'd like to know about a few of the other things we do that we  
haven't already covered:

- J-blocks are used for all exterior lights, receptacles, meters, etc.
- Bedroom ceiling fixtures are wired for paddle fans
- Basement ceilings are kept "clear-span" wherever possible
- Trusses are used for all floor framing to maximize flexibility
- Exterior grades are established by Civil Engineering professionals
- "End-use" layouts are provided as part of basement planning
- Homesites are "top soiled" prior to hydro seeding
- Garage and porch floors are supported on foundation walls (interior or exterior "brickledges"), wherever possible
- Hardware is "finish-matched" (door knobs, hinges, light fixtures) throughout the home
- Garages are "full-sized" and designed to accommodate two vehicles, plus storage
- All slab foundations, including garages and porches, are treated to prevent insect infestation
- Driveways and sidewalks are reinforced concrete - never asphalt
