## Visiting Your Home (while it's under construction)

- The first time you'll visit your home is before it's built! Once your Project Manager has worked with you to put together all of the details on your home, you'll sit down with our entire "construction team" to go over all of those details. It's a great time to ask any final questions before construction gets underway.
- During construction, we encourage you to visit as often as you can, during non-working hours (working hours are Mon. - Fri. between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.)
- Once we've got all of your mechanical systems "roughed-in", we'll conduct a "mechanical verification" with you to make sure that everything is where it's supposed to be, before we insulate and drywall.
- As soon as we have your home in a "lock-up" state, we'll get you a set of keys so that you have access at your convenience.
- A few days before closing, we'll do another "buyers orientation" to ensure that we've got all the details covered, and you will be able to move into a "completed" home.
